All-Stars Karate: Scituate Recreation's Multi-Purpose Room

A karate program designed to meet the physical, cognitive, social, and emotional needs of its participants. Students who participate in a karate program exhibit increased mobility, memorization and self-esteem. Program goals are to help children improve balance and coordination; strength, physical and motor skills; self defense; awareness and attention; and patience and determination. (This program will provide facilitative assistance for children with special needs. Students who would enjoy a less formal martial arts curriculum are also encouraged to attend.) Program is open to children in grades 1-8. *We ask that you register your child well in advance. If you register your child within 10 days of the program start date, your child's start date may be delayed one week to assure proper staffing.* 8 weeks
